- 10 The risen Jesus visited his followers. • Jesus Christ promised that the Holy Spirit would come to his followers. • The Holy Spirit was sent to Jesus' followers. • The Holy Spirit is the Third Person of the Blessed Trinity.
- 11 The Church began on Pentecost. • The first members of the Church did many things together. • The Holy Spirit helped the Church to grow. • The Holy Spirit helps the Church today.
- 12 The Apostles led and cared for the Church. • The bishops lead and care for the Church. • The pope leads and cares for the whole Church. • The Church serves others.
- 13 The Church has a special time of waiting.
- 14 At Christmas the Church celebrates the birth of Jesus.
