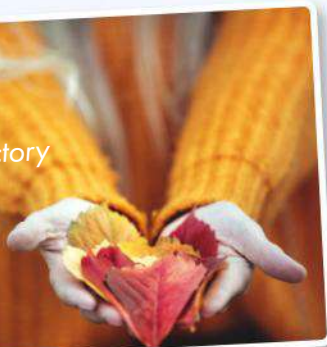

Why we Give?

Think back to the experiences for which you are grateful:

- For the gift of Jesus Christ freely given in the Eucharist and all the sacraments;
- The Word of God generously shared in Scripture;
- The intercession of the Saints;
- The ministry of priests and deacons, the holy women and men in religious orders, and countless lay people who use their gifts to proclaim the Gospel, to teach our children and to serve the poor and vulnerable among us.

In a challenging world, gratitude is life changing and life sustaining. It lifts our spirits and calls attention to the blessings we have received.

Grateful believers know that the work of the Church must continue so that the saving love of Jesus Christ is known in all generations.

What is Sacrificial Giving?

“ Sacrificial Giving begins with the recognition that everything we have has been given to us by God and is based on an understanding that as Christian stewards, we receive God's gifts gratefully, cultivate them responsibly, share them lovingly in justice with others, and return them with increase to the Lord. ”

– United States Bishops' Pastoral Letter on Stewardship

PLANNED

The decision to give is just that – a decision, that requires thought and prayer. Giving is integrated with other financial decisions as part of a careful, intentional response to God's generosity.

A PRIORITY

Part of our planning ensures that we give the “first fruits” – gifts given first and not after obligations have been satisfied.

SACRIFICIAL

Our gift becomes sacrificial when it comes from our substance rather than our leftover – and when we return to the Lord with increase – progressive giving. We act on our belief that our security lies not in our material resources, but in God's abundant graces.

AN EXPRESSION OF GRATITUDE

If we truly believe that God gives us all that we have, gratitude is our first response. We create a covenant to further God's kingdom – and we give through our parish because it is the body which bears witness to the values and love in action we embrace.

COVENANT WEEKEND

TAKE A STEP NOW FOR YOUR 2025 GIVING

We, as a parish, take the next few weeks to reflect upon the personal gifts we each have received as well as God’s invitation to a life of stewardship. Our Sacrificial Giving 2025 theme is “Thanks Be to God”, and our focus is on renewing our spiritual commitment to place God first and foremost in our lives through prayer, participation through service, and sacrifice by taking a step in giving to support His Church today and into the future.

To make our collective statement of faith, we have deemed the second and third weekends of this month “Covenant Weekends”, trusting that each will respond with the fullest commitment. Your new commitment will begin in January 2025.

Our parish goal is 100 percent participation, each pledging what they can, for every gift matters. What happens on covenant weekend will set the course of all the ministries and services at St. Mary Magdalen Church, School and Early Learning Center – an investment for next year and beyond.

In the mail and at church, you will receive stewardship invitations that include a 2025 Sacrificial Giving Commitment Card. Please take the time to prayerfully read and reflect on this information so you can complete your commitment card at Mass, drop it off at the office or renew through the parish website Pledge Online portal: www.stmarymagdalen.org. It is not legally binding and may be changed any time by contacting the Parish Office.

ROLES OF STEWARDS OF THE CHURCH

Stewards of God’s gifts are not passive beneficiaries. It is the personal responsibility of each one of us as stewards of the Church to participate in carrying out its mission:

- Parents, who nurture their children in the light of faith;
- Parishioners, who work in concrete ways to make their parishes true communities of faith and vibrant sources of service to the larger community;
- All Catholics, who give generous support—time, money, prayers, and personal service according to their circumstances—to parish and diocesan programs and to the universal Church.

YOUTH STEWARDSHIP FOR EVERY GENERATION

Every Sunday we place at the altar a basket and ask our youngsters to bring forth their stewardship envelopes. This provides them a way to share how they use their gifts from God -- good deeds, prayers, any number of ways they offer their time, talent and yes, their treasure!

Teaching to give at a young age helps start children on a path of giving that has the potential to last a lifetime. Over time, through conversations, modeling, and practicing stewardship, youth gain a better understanding of why stewardship is important and how it impacts them spiritually as well.

An intentional response to support my parish

1. WHAT PORTION OF MY INCOME WILL I GIVE?

Everything we have comes from God, so in that sense we owe everything to God. When deciding what portion to give, think about whether it is sacrificial and proportionate to what we have received from God. Prayerfully consider moving toward the biblical example of giving 10% of your income (a tithe) as an expression of your gratitude to God for the many gifts you have received. Consider taking a step towards this goal. For example, if you currently give 5% of your income to charity, take a step and give 6% this next year.

2. HOW WILL I DISTRIBUTE MY GIFT?

As Catholics, we are asked to divide our total giving - one half to our parish (our primary faith community, where we celebrate Sunday Mass and other Sacraments, and where faith is nourished and lived out) and the other half to charities of our choice. By taking time to plan our giving, it will relieve some of the anxiety that may accompany requests from other charities throughout the year and help make your giving a joyful experience.
